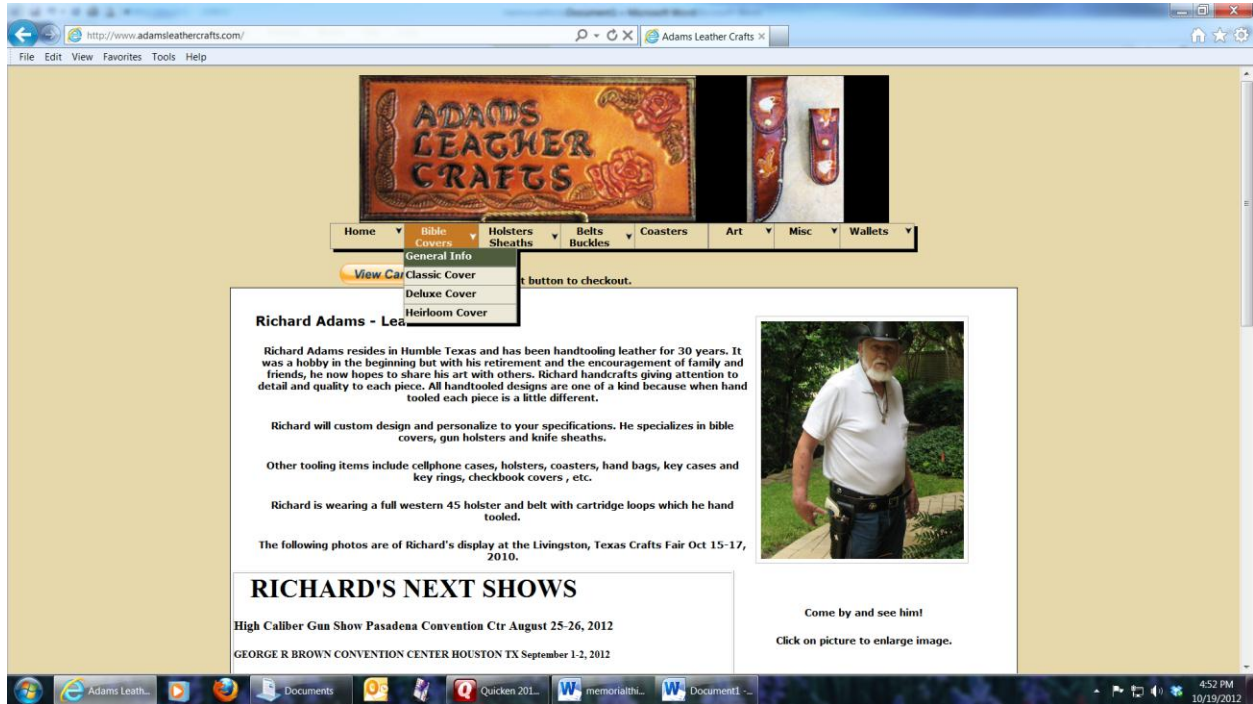


COMPATIBILITY VIEWING PROBLEMS OF DROP DOWN MENUS AND MICROSOFT INTERNET EXPLORER.

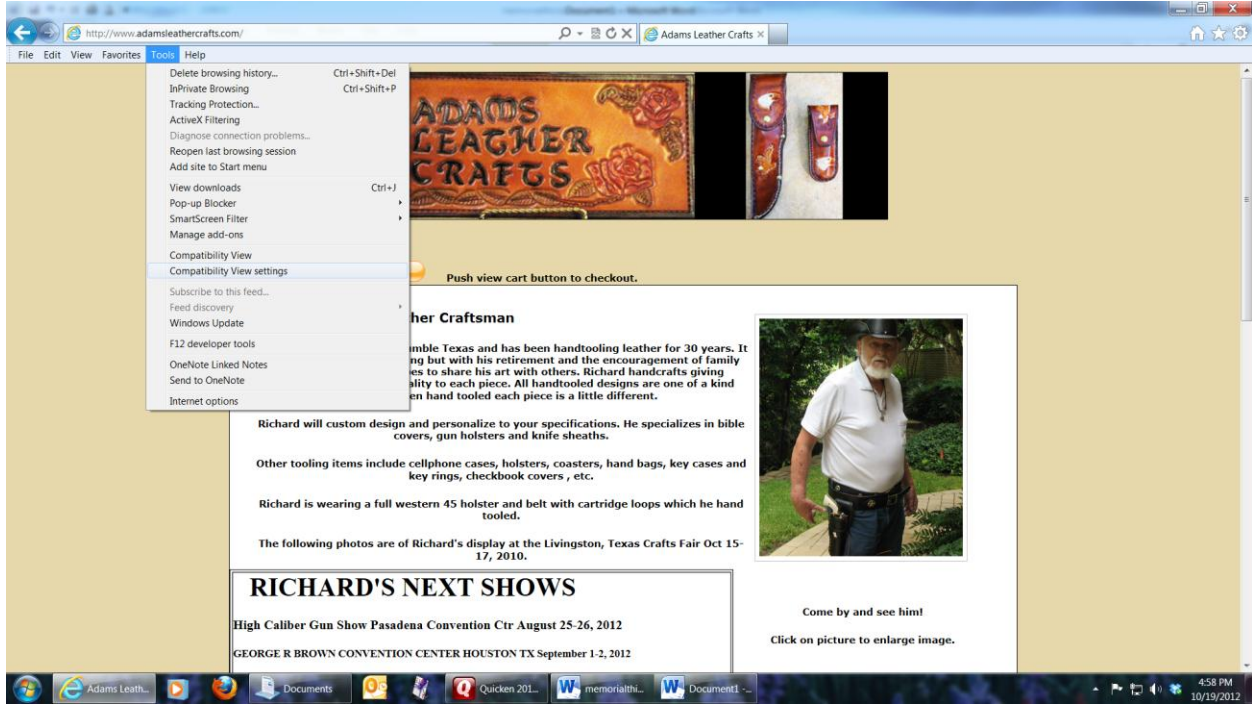
Can you view the menu and can you put your cursor on any menu choice and see the menu drop down on the adamsleathercrafts.com website as in the screen shot below:



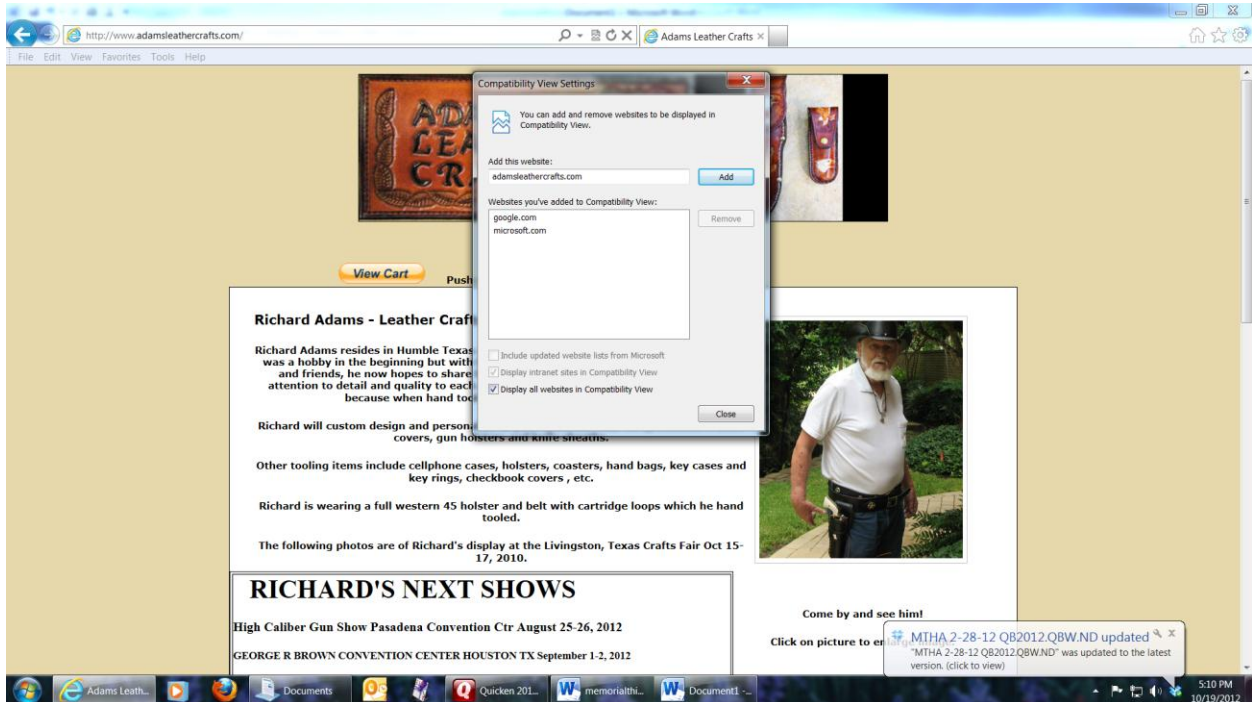
Or do you see a screen without menus like below and you are using Microsoft Explorer Browser then there is a compatibility view problem which can easily be fixed.




To fix the compatibility view problem, click on Tools on the menu toolbar (File Edit Favorites Tools Help) of Microsoft Internet Explorer Browser. Click on the Compatibility View settings.



Near the bottom of the Compatibility View Settings screen, check the box for Display all websites in Compatibility View then hit close at the bottom right of the screen.



The screen will refresh and now you should see menus below the Adams Leather Crafts logo as in the following screen.
